

Regulations on Academic Probation and Academic Dismissal

Article 1 (Purpose)

The purpose of these Regulations is to prescribe detailed matters concerning academic probation and academic dismissal pursuant to Articles 55 and 56 of the Academic Regulations of Woosong University (hereinafter referred to as the “University”).

Article 2 (Subjects of Application)

- ① A student whose academic performance is poor during enrollment—specifically, whose GPA for the first and summer semesters, or for the second and winter semesters, falls below 1.50—shall be placed on **academic probation**.
- ② Students who receive academic probation **three consecutive times or four times in total** may be subject to academic dismissal.
- ③ Grades earned with fewer than the minimum enrollment of 9 credits shall not be counted toward probation or dismissal evaluation.
- ④ Notwithstanding Paragraph ②, if the student clearly demonstrates intent to continue studies, dismissal may be waived upon: Review by the Department-level Evaluation Committee, and Approval by the President.

Article 3 (Confirmation)

Within **four weeks** after the completion of academic performance processing for the first and summer semesters, and for the second and winter semesters, students subject to academic probation or academic dismissal shall be identified. Such cases shall be confirmed by the departmental evaluation committee and reviewed by the Academic Evaluation Committee, and finalized by the President..

Article 4 (Timing of Imposition)

Academic probation and dismissal shall be imposed within **four weeks after completion of semester grade processing**.

Article 5 (Notification)

- ① Students and their respective departments shall be notified of probation or dismissal **without delay**.
- ② Departments shall provide **special academic guidance** to students placed on probation.

Article 6 (Course Registration and Credit Limit)

- ① Students placed on academic probation may have their course load limited to **a maximum of 15 credits per semester (Spring/Fall)**.
- ② Students receiving probation **two consecutive times or more** may be restricted from enrolling in advanced-level courses.

Article 6-2 (Participation in Learning Programs)

Students placed on academic probation shall participate in **at least one learning support program** operated by the Teaching and Learning Development Center before or after the beginning of the following semester.

Article 7 (Academic Record Management)

Once probation or dismissal is finalized and notification is completed, the record shall be **promptly updated in the student’s academic record**.

Article 8 (Miscellaneous)

Matters concerning academic probation and academic dismissal not specified in the Academic Regulations or these regulations shall be determined separately by the President following deliberation by the Academic Evaluation Management Committee and the Academic Affairs Committee.
