

# Regulations on the Operation of Extracurricular Programs

## Article 1 (Purpose)

The purpose of these Regulations is to prescribe matters concerning the operation of extracurricular programs aimed at fostering creative, global, professional, and interdisciplinary talents by enhancing students' learning competencies and character development at Woosong University (hereinafter referred to as the "University").

## Article 2 (Definition)

"Extracurricular Programs" refer to educational activities conducted in addition to the formal curriculum defined in Article 26 of the Academic Regulations, including lectures, experiments, practical training, study groups, and special seminars.

## Article 3 (Types of Programs)

- ① The University may operate the following types of extracurricular programs:
  1. Learning skills programs operated by the Teaching and Learning Development Center
  2. Liberal education programs for language proficiency and character development operated by the Liberal Education Center
  3. Career development and employment competency programs operated by the Career Development Center
  4. Leadership and social service programs operated by the Student Affairs Office (Student Coaching Center)
  5. Korean language programs operated by the Korean Language Institute
  6. IT training programs for employment operated by the IT Education Center
  7. Certification preparation special lecture programs
  8. Other programs supporting students on graduation deferment or employment/entrepreneurship activities
- ② Programs not listed above may be operated with approval from the President.

## Article 4 (Eligibility for Participation)

Eligibility for extracurricular programs shall be limited to enrolled students of the University. However, depending on the program, graduates who have completed coursework (non-degree completion) may also participate.

## Article 5 (Scope and Method of Operation)

- ① In principle, all extracurricular programs shall be open to students; however, participation may be limited based on program characteristics or capacity.
- ② Extracurricular programs shall not normally grant credits or classification; however, in exceptional cases, up to **1 credit** may be awarded with approval from the President.
- ③ Completion results may be graded depending on program characteristics, and when graded, shall be recorded as **Pass/Fail (P/F)**.
- ④ Programs may be operated on a **regular (semester-based)** or **irregular (short-term or special lecture)** basis.

## Article 6 (Financial Support)

The University shall provide financial support for the operation of extracurricular programs as follows:

1. **University Funding:** Budget allocation for extracurricular programs in the annual budget
2. **Government Funding:** Budget allocation within the scope of national support projects

3. **Additional Support:** Additional funding in accordance with university budgeting regulations when necessary

**Article 7 (Application for Participation)**

Students wishing to participate in extracurricular programs must apply within the designated application period using the prescribed format for each program.

**Article 8 (Obligation of Operation)**

- ① The department or center operating extracurricular programs shall announce and promote the programs in advance through the University website and bulletin boards, unless exceptional circumstances apply.
- ② The operating department or center shall report the results of the program to the President.

**Article 9 (Relationship with Other Regulations)**

- ① Certain extracurricular programs may be linked to graduation requirements or individual student career management; in such cases, relevant regulations shall apply.
- ② These Regulations shall be applied in conjunction with the Academic Regulations of the University to ensure efficient academic administration.

**Article 10 (Miscellaneous)**

Matters not specified in these Regulations shall follow the Academic Regulations of the University, and detailed operational guidelines shall be determined separately by the President.
